

Water Restriction Now in Place

District Council is advising residents of a water restriction now in place throughout the district. The restriction means residents can only use a hose, micro-spray or automatic irrigation system on alternate days, and in some areas, during specific time periods, to help conserve water.

"In summer, exceptional demand for water can sometimes limit the ability of the water schemes to consistently deliver water to all properties at the required pressure," says Council Service Delivery Group Manager Neil McCann. "The Water restriction policy ensures conservation of water to even out demand which enables residents to continue to enjoy reasonable use of water for gardening and non-essential purposes," he added.
